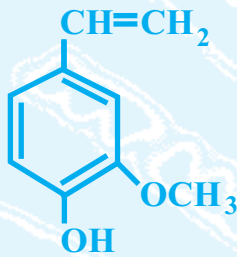


Flavorfile



The active component in this FlavorActiV™ Beer Flavour Standard is 4-vinyl guaiacol
(*syn.* 2-methoxy-4-vinyl-phenol)

PHENOLIC

Associated terms

- Spicy
- Herbal
- Clove-like

Importance

Usually an **off-flavour**. Major flavour impact character of some products, *eg* wheat beers.

Origins

Produced by **wild yeasts** or **speciality yeasts**.

Analysis

- Spectrophotometry
- High Performance Liquid Chromatography

Typical concentration in beer

0.05 - 0.55 mg/l

Approximate flavour threshold

0.2 mg/l

Beer Flavour Wheel number

0500

Remarks

Commonly used as a reference standard by many brewing companies. Note that there are several types of phenolic characters, of which this represents only one.
